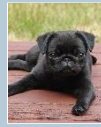

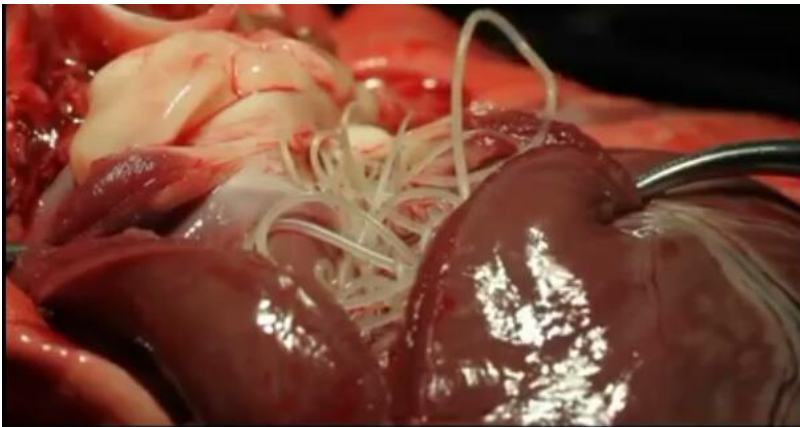

April is Heartworm Awareness Month

Heartworm disease is a serious **disease** that can cause severe lung and artery damage, heart failure and ultimately, if not treated, can cause death. It is caused by a parasitic worm called *Dirofilaria immitis*. The worms are spread through the bite of an infected mosquito. Not all mosquitos carry the disease, but it is impossible to detect which ones do and which ones do not. That is not a lottery worth playing!!!

Did you know...A routine heartworm test recommended by your veterinarian cannot detect a heartworm infection for up to 6 months after initial infection? That is why we stress the importance of having your pet on a monthly preventative. Treatment for a heartworm positive dog is very costly and painful.

Ask a staff member about the many different options we offer in preventing this nasty disease.
